1700 J J Seabrook Cowboy Pool

We installed our "cowboy pool" in 2021 and we've loved it! Hope you will too!

Caring for it is super easy. Here's what we do:

- The INTEX pump keeps the pool clean and filters out dirt and grime. We replace
 the filter with the Intex 29000 Swimming Pool Easy Set Type A Replacement
 Filter Pump Cartridge as needed. (The filter will be visibly dirty when it's time to
 replace it). You can get these on Amazon (see link above). A 3-pack was about
 \$14 last time we checked.
 - To replace the filter, turn the knob on the hose attaching to the pool to stop the flow of water. Then unscrew the large cap on the top of the INTEX pump. You can pull out the old filter, replace it with the new filter, screw the top back on, and restart the flow of pool water. Slightly loosen the smaller screw on the cap to allow any air to leave the filter. Tighten again when the air has left and water comes from the cap.
 - The outdoor power outlet powering the pump/filter is on the left side of the retaining wall. After a storm, we occasionally need to reset the pump from the power outlet by hitting "reset" on the plug. If you ever need to flip the breaker for the pool, in the breaker box on the back of the house (bottom left switch, marked with a Sharpie).
- Chlorine tablets keep the pool clean from germs and things. We add 1-2 small chlorine tablets to a little chlorine floater when it's empty. We'll leave the turtle. If you prefer a flamingo, you can find it here.
- We're leaving you the pool cover, but we found we didn't really need it when the
 pool was filled in the warm weather months. Between the filter/pump, the
 chlorine, and an occasional use of a little pool skimmer, it looked great.
